ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR YEAR 7

ST CATHERINE'S SCHOLARSHIP

Open to internal applicants

For a girl who has attended St Catherine's junior school for one year or longer. Full tuition fees.

FIELDING SCHOLARSHIP

Open to internal and external applicants

For academic excellence. A bequest from the five Fielding sisters, students at St Catherine's School between 1900 and 1918. Full tuition fees.

GENERAL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Open to internal and external applicants

For girls who are considered to have exceptional academic ability and potential. Partial tuition fees.

CLAREMONT SCHOLARSHIP

Open to students from Claremont College, Randwick.

Full or partial tuition fees.

ALL-ROUNDER SCHOLARSHIPS

Open to external applicants Years 7 to 10

For a girl who exhibits excellence in a particular area such as sport. Full or partial tuition fees.

She will have

- sound academic ability
- a desire to contribute to the life of the school in her particular performance area
- a letter of recommendation from a coach or tutor.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Open to internal and external applicants Years 7 to 11

St Catherine's School has a long tradition of promoting excellence in music through our music program. We are looking for girls who have a passion for music and wish to see the dedication to their studies celebrated and nurtured. Full or partial tuition fees.

The successful candidate would:

- study music within her academic program
- contribute fully to the musical life of the school through ensembles and performances
- have highly developed skills on her preferred instrument

An audition will include:

- sight reading
- aural tests
- performance of two contrasting pieces
- another piece on a second instrument (optional)
- an interview
- a portfolio of musical achievements

COUNTRY BOARDING SCHOLARSHIP

Open to Years 7 to 11 means-related

Our country boarding scholarships reflect the school's continuing commitment to providing a great education for girls from regional Australia.

Awarded each year to girls who have

- a commitment to their studies
- good academic ability
- a willingness to be involved in school life

Designed for families who would normally not consider a fee-based school, we can cover partial or full tuition fees until the end of Year 12. Boarding fees will still be payable.

THE FAITH PATTERSON SCHOLARSHIP

Open to students in Year 10 for Years 11 and 12.

This means tested scholarship honours former headmistress Miss Faith Patterson AM and covers 50% of tuition fees. It is awarded every second year. Applicants should sit the scholarship test in the year before proposed entry and will be selected based on the following criteria:

- A demonstrated need for the scholarship
- Demonstrated engagement in school life and activities
- Sound academic achievement
- Commitment to studies

Next open in November 2020 for 2022.

THE JANE BARKER SCHOLARSHIP

Open to descendents of Old Girls Years 7 to 11

Jane Barker was the founder of St Catherine's School. This scholarship will be awarded to a daughter or grand-daughter of an Old Girl of St Catherine's who would not otherwise be able to attend the school. It is open to all girls every second year. Means-tested, full or partial tuition fees.

Applicants should

- Sit the scholarship test in the year before proposed entry
- Show an ability to contribute to the school community
- Prove to be a descendent of an Old Girl

Open in 2019 for a place in 2021.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

STEP 1 Visit **Academic Assessment Services** for information about the scholarship exam.

STEP 2 Register for the exam and pay the examination fee. Registration for 2020 opens 26 November 2018.

STEP 3 Complete an **enrolment application form**. Existing St Catherine's students and families who have previously submitted the form are not required to do so again.

Provide a **portfolio** that includes:

a. Two most recent school reports, a copy of NAPLAN results, a list of recent awards and achievements. Please do not include original documents, copies only.

b. The scholarship applicant is to complete a statement in her own words "Why I want to attend St Catherine's" in 100 words or less.

AUSTRALIAN INDIGENOUS EDUCATION

FOUNDATION (AIEF) we work closely with AIEF to provide places to Indigenous students who would like to be boarders at our school.

When applying for an AIEF scholarship please provide

- a letter from your local AECG, or Head of School, supporting your application
- copies of the two most recent school and NAPLAN reports, please don't send originals
- copies of any awards or certificates
- the following completed forms

- **Centrelink form (Abstudy)**

- **AIEF scholarship application form**

- **An enrolment application form**

the \$200 enrolment application fee will be waived

Students applying for an Indigenous scholarship are not required to sit an exam. Consideration will be given to

- academic progress
- commitment to study
- participation in school and community activities
- the support of family, we ask for a small contribution from families as a measure of this support.
