Learn to Swim Program

- 1. How many classes can my child attend per week
- a. Learn to swim classes allow you to register for ONE class a week
- b. Stingray's pre-squads allow you to register for ONE Class a week
- c. Mako, Development, Power hour allow you to register for TWO sessions per week
- 2. What is the customer portal and how to book classes

You will be able to organise your child's lessons through the customer portal, IClassPro App, which can be downloaded on the IOS or Google Play app Store

Once successfully downloaded it will ask you for organisation name: **Steaths**The processed to log into your account

Please note that before booking a class you have contact the swim school and organised assessment

Once you have created account and requested to book the class. The swim school will approve and charge payment to your account.

- Step 1 Create your account on I Class Pro and add your children as student
- Step 2 Select their Learn to Swim level
- Step 3 select your child
- Step 4 select your preferred day/time
- Step 5 make your payment

3. How to sign up for direct debit

Our swimming fees are charged as soon as the booking is confirmed by us. The fees are charged to the students account and will show as outstanding payment in red until payment is made.

- 4. How do I mark my child absent if they can't attend

You can cancel your child out of a lesson through the customer portal. Please note: the Makeup token will not appear until after the regular lesson has been completed.

- Step 1 Go to account on Customer portal
- Step 2 cancel child out of lesson (A make-up token will be sent to your account)
 - 5. How do I book a make-up lesson
- Step 1 Check account to see if you have a valid make- up token
- Step 2 Find class you wish to book your child into
 - You can't select a class that occurs before your regular lesson
 - You must use the make-up token within two weeks of your cancelled lessons
- Step 3 Book your child into the class using the token
 - 6. How do I change the day/time of my child's lesson?

You can make changes via the customer portal

If you need to change days/times permanently due to unforeseen circumstances

Step 1 – using app request to transfer of class change, add reasons for this

If spot available, we will approve and send through email confirmation

Step 2 – if approved and pending availability, the swim school Manager will make the arrangements based on the information provided

General Enquires

- 1. How do I access the Aquatic Centre
- Aquatic Centre access is via Macpherson st. NO entry through the school
- 2. What is the pick-up and drop off process
