The Head of Artistic Gymnastics is responsible for the leadership of our recreational and competitive Artistic Gymnastics program within the schools Beyond the Curriculum (extra-curricular) program.

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Major responsibilities

- Provide Work closely with the Director of Sport and BTC and Head of BTC to ensure the gymnastics program aligns with the school's values.
- Develop and oversee the provision of comprehensive training programs for the various age groups and levels within the Artistic Gymnastics program.
- Mentoring and supervision of coaches; assisting them to achieve their desired level of coaching accreditation.
- Rostering of coaches to ensure appropriately qualified coaches are assigned to the various levels, keeping in mind the safety and development of each student.
- Co-ordinate set up and pack up of equipment for each session and perform safety checks of equipment and apparatus.
- Oversee team selection and entries for Gymnastics NSW, IPSHA and IGSA competitions.
- Attend Gymnastics NSW, IPSHA and IGSA clinics and competitions as required to support our athletes and coaches.
- Work collaboratively with the Sports and BTC departments staff to ensure the best outcomes for students who participate in a variety of cocurricular activities.

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- Actively contribute to the strategic planning and objective setting of the Sports and BTC departments.
- Attend relevant meetings and professional development as required.
- Liaise with parents regarding student's performance, competition reviews and goal setting.
- Monitor high standards of student appearance and behaviour.
- Maintain attendance records.
- Assist in recognising student achievement via awards, assembly reports and newsletter reports.
- Utilise the Sports and BTC administrators for assistance with operational tasks.
- Report to the Head of BTC for budget planning, risk management planning and all team selections.
